HAMILTON HAPPENINGS
ACCUSES CITY HOSPITAL OFFICIALS OF NEGLECT

Hamilton, March 28.—(Special.)—The board of health had a lively session this evening. Chairman Quinn made the charge that the city hospital authorities neglected to notify the medical health officer, Dr. Roberts, of diphtheria and contagious diseases that broke out in the hospital.

He produced a written complaint from a mother, who said her little girl, who was taken to the hospital for an operation, had contracted diphtheria. He had been informed of another case by a reputable and interesting development.

"These are not getting up an investigation to disprove these cases," he remarked.

The other members of the board thought it was Dr. Roberts' place to go after the hospital authorities. The doctor explained that it was a very difficult position in which to place him on account of professional etiquette. The other members of the board pointed out that it was the duty of the chairman and doctor to take action, and as both declared they would do their duty, interesting developments are looked for.

Squabble Over Salary.

Dr. Roberts, without consulting the board, accepted a year to the medical adviser to the board of education. Mr. Peebles thought the doctor had enough to do without that and there was a lively debate.

"You were always anxious to get the salary of my predecessor, Dr. Langrill, increased," remarked the doctor.

"That's because he was a first-class man," retorted Mr. Peebles.

"There are members of the board who think I should have more pay," "There are not very many."

With this exchange of compliments the matter dropped.
