VERDICT ONE DOLLAR AND COSTS AGAINST HAMILTON SPECTATOR

The Libel Suit Brought by Ex-Major Teetzel Was Heard Yesterday and Much Interest Was Manifested in It—Judge McMahon Charged Against the Paper.

Hamilton, April 12.—(Special.)—The libel suit brought by ex-Major Teetzel against The Spectator for \$10,000 began at the Assize Court this morning, and it lasted all day. Much interest was taken in it. J. P. Mayhew, K.C., of Stratford, and George C. Thomson, appeared for the plaintiff, and George Lynch-Staunton and John G. Gault for the defendant.

The paragraphs of the plaintiff objected to were: "The city's finances are in such bad shape that Mayor Teetzel has refused to sanction the expenditure of one dollar on fireworks or hacks, and he is the only person who can authorize the expenditure."

"If Mayor Teetzel had been an economist during the past two years as he is now, it would have been a very good thing for the taxpayers."

Mr. Teetzel on the Stand. The plaintiff took the stand in the morning. He testified that he had been elected Mayor last October and the refusal of the Council to accept his resignation, and that he had been elected Mayor on Jan. 14 last.

ASSESSMENT COMMISSION A FARGE Bill to Give Life to the Government Declared to Be Perfectly Innocent.
