

Chicago, July 24—Eddie Collins of the Chicago White Sox has climbed into second place among the American League batters, with an average of 388, but Ty Cobb is far in front of all, with 409 for the season, according to aver-ages published here today, including re-cords of Wednesday. The ten leading batters, including those who have play-ed in half the total games or more, are: Cobb, Detroit, 408; Collins, Chicago, 388; Veach, Detroit, 380; Fournier, Chicago, 318; Speaker, Boston, 317; Strunk, Philadelphia, 817; Lajoie, Philadelphia, 808; and Maisel, New York, 308. 
