

3. *Resolved*, that we earnestly request our people for the sake of their families and of the good of the church more strictly according to the word of God to observe the sabbath day to keep it holy.

4. *Resolved*, that we as a conference earnestly discontinue the running of street cars in our cities on the Lord's day.

Temperance.

We are persuaded that the power and malignity of Satan to destroy family peace, health and prosperity of state and church is nowhere revealed more than in the business of the liquor traffic, therefore

1. *Resolved*, that we consider the business and traffic of intoxicating drinks as contemptible and objectionable, and that no person making claim to morals or Christianity should be engaged in this defarious business, and we regret that our government encourages the licensing of such business.

2. *Resolved*, that we consider all who in any wise directly or indirectly encourage the licensing of said business as accessories to all misery and harm caused thereby.

3. *Resolved*, that we will earnestly endeavor by all proper means to counteract this business, and request our people with us according to our discipline to totally abstain and to work against this evil in every proper manner possible.

4. *Resolved*, that we rejoice in the power of the temperance movement of our land, and hope that soon this traffic will be totally discountenanced.

5. *Resolved*, that we again send a delegate to our Dominion Alliance.

6. *Resolved*, that we give up all party spirit in the election of our representatives and to support only such men as we know will be true to prohibition principles.

Since the form of the deeds of our church property is not as perfect as desired, therefore

Resolved, that a committee of three be appointed to investigate this matter.
