Scotch Families for Minto, N. B.

Fortnightly Cuban Service.
The William Thomson Company will run a fortnightly steamship service to Cuba as long as they are able to obtain cargoes. At the present time the indications are that there will be a good many potatoes shipped from St. John to Cuba this winter. The price of potatoes in Cuba is \$2.50 a barrel.

NEW SCHOOL MUST WAIT FOR MONEY

Commissioners Advise School Trustees to Defer Action on New North End Building—Money Scarce Now

A conference was held yesterday afternoon between the city commissioners and a committee of the School Board consisting of the Chairman, R. B. Emerson, Trustee George Day, Superintendent Bridges and Secretary Leavitt, with reference to the need of providing for the extension of the school accommodation in the North End, in the near future.

The members of the school committee pointed out that the present school accommodation in the North End is not up to modern requirements and that as the population in that quarter was increasing rapidly it would soon be necessary to erect a new building.

They said they did not plan on putting up a building just now, but thought they should secure a site for a building as soon as possible, because the price of land was steadily advancing.

The city commissioners said that money was needed for practically all the civic services, and that as the school board gets a considerable portion of the tax payers' money it ought to go slowly. They recognized the importance of keeping the school system up to the requirements, and expressed their appreciation of the action of the Board in conferring with them on the matter, as the Board had full power to act without consulting the city authorities.

The school trustees said they would take no action until the city commissioners had opportunity to look into the situation in the North End, when they felt the necessity of securing a site for a new building would be recognized. The school board has several possible sites in view.

MINISTERS MAY SECURE AN INCREASE

Methodist Conference Committees Are at Work to This End

SUGGESTS MINIMUM OF \$900 PER YEAR

Expectation is That This Can Be Arranged in 1913—Grants Made Yesterday to Home Mission Stations

The joint meetings of missionary committees of the New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island conferences of the Methodist church were continued yesterday in Centenary church.

The principal business of the day's sessions was the discussion of ways and means by which all members of the Home Mission Station be paid the disciplinary salary of \$900 clear of house keep and house rent. No arrangement was reached for the present year, but plans for working out a system for next year were considered, and it is probable that a way will be devised by which the matter can be worked out. To effect this a re-arrangement of the circuits will be made and the different circuits will be visited by committees appointed especially for the purpose.

A resolution of appreciation was tendered Rev. Thomas Marshall, who is retiring from the office of home mission secretary to go to Petrolia, Charlottetown, P. E. Island. The position has been offered to Rev. George Stiles, but he said last evening that he will probably not decide for a week or ten days.

A resolution was passed by the committee expressing their pleasure in the visit of Rev. James Allen, of Toronto, who is the Canadian Home Secretary of the board.

The following resolution of regret at the death of Dr. J. R. Inch was passed by the committee:

"Resolved, that this conference has learned with regret of the death of Dr. J. R. Inch, one of its members, and have placed on its records its profound sense of its loss, and its appreciation of the eminent services rendered by him through so many years in connection with the various institutions of our church. It also expresses to his family its sympathy in their loss and its regret that the same has fallen them."

Grants to Missions.
The matter of grants to the different missions of the conference was taken up and the following amounts agreed upon:
Silver Falls, \$245; Springfield, \$400; St. Martin's, \$250; Jerusalem, \$375; Welford, \$135; Kingston, \$415; Stanley, \$875; Bathurst, \$240; Keswick, \$145; Shefield, \$100; Deer Island, \$380; Gagetown, \$455; Florenceville, \$125; Andover, \$255; Tobique, \$385; Richibucto, \$440; Petrolia, \$440; Harcourt, \$425; Gaspé and Cape Oro, \$685; Tantramar, \$50; Shediac, \$415; Dorchester, \$475; Albert, \$290; Alma, \$210; Hillside, \$280; Petticoe, \$145; Winalow, \$405; Montague, \$340; Souris, \$405; Mount Stewart, \$335; Bedford, \$300.

The above amounts with what the mission raises give each married minister \$300, with \$75 extra for horse keep and free parsonages.

The committee gave consent to the Sackville church to sell a strip of land to the university, but the sale of the university in turn selling it to the government for a site for a new post office.

LOCAL MAN LOSES EYE

One St. John Baseball Fan Who Will Remember World's Series—Will Seek to Recover Damages

There is one young man in the city who will long remember his trip to Boston last week where he went to witness some of the world's series baseball games. As the result of the visit he has lost his right eye.

One evening early in the week he was taking in the sights along Court street with a small rifle. The bullet, after striking the target, burst and a small piece of lead rebounded, and struck the St. John man in the eye. The injured man hastened to a doctor and had his eye dressed. The doctor informed him at the time that he would probably lose the sight of the eye as he had been seriously injured.

The injured man arrived home on Saturday and on Monday when he removed the bandage from his eye he found to his sorrow that he had completely lost the sight in it.

Before leaving Boston he placed his claim in the hands of a lawyer and will request heavy damages from the owner of the shooting gallery. To the Standard last night he said he did not expect that the case would ever go to court, as the owner of the gallery is the owner of a number of bowling alleys and shooting galleries, and is said to be worth considerable money. He is expected to pay the claim as soon as he receives the proof that the young man has lost the sight of the eye, and the loss was caused in the manner stated.
