PRICE HAS GONE UP TO \$1.05 PER BARREL

Inspectors Busy Finding Out Sections Infected with Powdery Scab - An Inhuman Father's Crime.

Hartland, Feb. 6—The stories of immense quantities of potatoes going to waste in Carleton and Victoria counties on account of the embargo on the New Brunswick product fall rather flat when it is known that the dealers cannot get enough stock to fill the upper Canadian orders. Hatfield & Scott, one of the largest shippers in this section, have been obliged to cancel about one-third of their orders during January on account of their inability to get enough to the tubers to satisfy the demand. And, although the price has risen to \$1.05 at this writing, there are comparatively few offering. Notwithstanding the scarcity known, this firm shipped during the month of January one-hundred cas of potatoes to upper Canadian points. This would mean 30,000 barrels, or a distribution of about \$30,000 among the farmers of Carleton and Victoria counties.

On Thursday three inspectors started out from here under instructionsfrom the local government to fer; et out any potatoes affected with the powdery scab. Already ten inspectors have been appointed and will be scattered over these two counties in a few days, and the results of their labors will be the segregation of the journ will be the segregation of the good from the bad to such an extent that next year's crop should be practically free from the disease.
