To begin with, there is the plain running team that almost exeryone knows. This consists in putting the right sides of two pleees of material together, edges even and using a plain running stitch strengthened, maybe, by an occasional back-stitch to hold them together, says a writer in a recent number of an North American, Philadelphia.

Next comes the French seam. This is used when a neat finish is required or, the wrong side of a garment and mostly for soft materials. The vrong sides of the scaterials are not together and a running seam made; this is trimmed off very closely, and the seam turned in and basted closely along the top, when a running seam is again taken on the wrong side, inclosing the rough edges of the right-side seam.

A fell seam is another neat finish for the wrong side, and may be used on thicker material than the French seam it consists of running a seam on the wrong side, with a rather good allowance of material above the seam. The edge toward you is then
