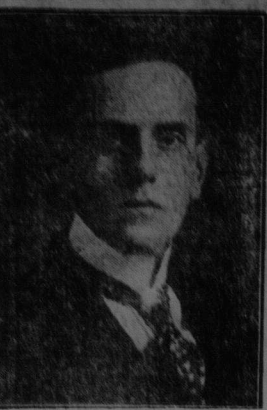

STOCKS, BONDS AND PRODUCE

STRONG RECOVERY IN ALL ISSUES ON STOCK MARKET

From Three to Twenty Point Gains Made, Indicating Reactionary Forces Are in Retreat.

New York, Nov. 20.—A comprehensive rally of from three to twenty points in the stock market today gave promise that reactionary influences are in retreat. The rise followed early intimations that the defeat of the Peace Treaty might precipitate another decline.

Stocks were heavy—almost weak—at the outset, but this condition was speedily overcome, even though exchanges on London and other foreign centres fell to lowest quotations ever recorded here.

From the first rally stocks showed almost steady improvement, the advances being attended by the easiest money in more than a week. Through the session brokers reported substantial buying, including many "old lots" purchased by the usual bargain hunters.

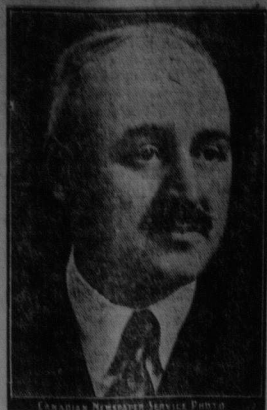
Only moderate amounts of money were in demand at the opening rate of ten per cent, the inquiry evidently being so light as to cause a drop to six per cent, with the approach of the final hour. Time money was again quoted unchanged, but reports credited interior institutions with making loans at as low as seven and a quarter per cent.

The strength of recent weak issues as Crucible Steel and General Motors and Mexican Petroleum, leaders in their respective groups, suggested that the shorts were having some trouble in covering.

This was applicable to many too speculative stocks of which the available supply seemed very scant. Maximum prices were made in the final dealings when United States Steel and other leaders were at their best. Sales amounted to 1,000,000 shares.

International issues rallied, but the domestic bond list, including the Liberty group, was moderately lower. Total sales, par value aggregated \$14,500,000.

Old United States bonds were unchanged on call.

SHARP ADVANCES IN MOTOR STOCKS

(McDougall and Cowans.)
New York, Nov. 20.—After some irregularity and reaction around noon the market hardened and later moved up when call money rates dropped to 8 per cent. Some sharp advances were made in the motor stocks and the Oils were stimulated by the general advance in oil prices. Crucible led the Steel group with an advance of some 17 or 18 points for the day and other Steel and Equipment issues gained several points all around. Opinion on the probable results of the failure of the Senate to ratify the Peace Treaty before the adjournment of the special session was sharply divided, but the event at least lent some of the depressing influence it had exerted during the morning. The list continued to gain strength practically up to the close and prices were about the best of the day on the market closing.
