Sir,

I have to <sup>thank you for</sup> acknowledge the  
rec<sup>d</sup>. of your letter of the 7<sup>th</sup> ult.  
reporting <sup>on</sup> the Indian Schools  
under your supervision; and  
to inform you that Mr. Sup<sup>t</sup>.  
Gilkinson has been advised that  
unless the Indians supply the necessary  
quantity of fuel for <sup>and keep them</sup> the  
school houses, or <sup>and keep them</sup> repairs, an appropria-  
tion will be made from their funds  
for those objects.

As regards the Roman School  
there ~~is~~ <sup>the Dept. has</sup> no objection, as far  
as the Dept. is concerned, to the Methodist  
Society assuming the supervision  
thereof, ~~provided~~ <sup>finding</sup> that Society is  
willing to contribute the  
means of support.
