Where horsen are thin in the fall no doubt it would be advisable to feed them well during the first month or six weeks after the seasons work was over.

Horses that are out every day derive

Horses that are out every day during the winter take considerable exercise, consequently do not require the same consequently do not require the same amount of attention in hardening for the spring work, as horses that have been kept in the stable all winter. In order to complete the experiment the horses are usually kept on the pasture until March 31st. By that time there
