such Justice or Justices of the Peace, and the overplus, after such penalties and the charges of such distress and sale are deducted, shall be returned on demand to the owner of such goods and chattels, and one half of such penalties, respectively, when paid and levied, shall belong to Her Majesty, and the other half to the person suing for the same.

Height of arches above stream.

XXII. Provided always, that the said Bridge hereby authorized to be constructed in the north-east branch of the River Nicolet, shall have under its arches, an elevation of six feet above the highest waters, with a space not less than fifty feet between each abutment.

Public Act. XXIII. This Act shall be a public Act.
