## BILL.

## An Act respecting the admission into this Province of Foreign re-prints of British Copy-right Books.

${ }_{2}$ WHEREAS it would be of great advantage that Preamble. Foreigu re-prints of British Copy-right Books should be allowed to be imported into this Province on 4 payment of a fair duty thereon, the proceeds whereof should be appropriated as equity may require: Be it 6 therefore enacted, \&c.
and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that 8 whenever the Act or Aets of the Parliament of the United Kingdom now-in force in that behalf, shail be so amended 10 as to permit the importation into this Province of Books wherein the copy-right shall be subsisting, first composed 12 or written or printed in the United Kingdom, and printed or re-printed iin any other Country, and with regard to 14 which the notice to the Commissioners of Custons required by such Act or Acts shall have been given, then it 16 shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to impose an ad valorem duty not exceeding twenty per centum, on any 18 such Books as aforesaid imported inta this Province, and from time to time to alter the same (nof exceeding in any 20 case the rate aforesaid) and from time to time to establish such regulations and conditions as may be consistent with 22 any Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom then in force, and as he may deem requisite and equitable, with 24 regard to the admission of such Books and to the distribution of the proceeds of such duty to or among the party or 26 parties beneficially interested in the copy-right; Provided Proviso. always, that no such order in Council shall impose a duty 28 on the importatation of any Book which may now be imported free from duty.
