

## PREFACE.

This volume provides references of all proceedings of the House of Commons of Canada, for the period of ten years, from the time of the Union of the Provinces into one Dominion, to the close of the year 1876.

The work, in accordance with instructions, has been so prepared as to cover every subject referred to in the Journals during the above-mentioned period. All matters relating to the same subject are brought together under one head, so that the record of each is complete with references and cross-references.

In addition to the General Index to the Journals, there will be found at the end of this volume (see *page 507*) a General Index to the Sessional Papers of both Houses for the same period, so prepared that all Accounts and Papers, Returns to Addresses and Orders are arranged alphabetically, showing the year, the number of Sessional Paper, and whether they have been printed or otherwise.

Prepared under the direction of the Clerk of the House, in accordance with the recommendation of the Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons on the Printing of Parliament, presented on the 8th March, 1877, and concurred in by both Houses.
