The surplus will result from an estimated \$1,179,000 underspending on various regional programs. An estimated surplus from 1974 fell \$637,000 below expectations.

# The region has instituted cost-cutting efforts in the closing months of 1975 in an attempt to minimize increases in 1976 regional taxes. Earlier reports showed that to maintain present level of regional services, the levy would have to be increased by 18 percent. Council's administration and finance committee has approved the move without debate as a result of a short report from regional clerk chard Frost.


He stated that in the course of preparing
