Westfield a boat came there on the 14th
Instant that a Town called Brattleboro of
about 60 families newly settled chiefly
by Irish was cut off & situated about 10
Miles north east from of Town called
Dunbar being the next to Deerfield the
particulars they did not know we sent on
the 10th Instant by these Men a Letter to
show that we did advise them of their
Approaching Danger from the Savages

As we have had sufficient proof of the
many outrages committed on his Majes
Subjects in America by the Indians thro
the Insinuations of the French & are
among them in Canada & do not know
how the Indians may be prevailed upon to
attack us and perhaps first at Block
house at Mount Burnet wherefor we
humbly propose that his Excel^{ty} will be
pleased to order a same to be established
in the best manner it can be

We are informed of these two men from
Boston had a Letter from a Lieut. Gov.
Council & Assembly & one of a Lieut. Gov.
Directed to Col^l. Peter & John Schuyler
on which the latter went from hence
yesterday in order to go for Boston, that
they intend to make him Chief of all
their forces, if he does accept of it we
leave your Excel^{ty} to Judge what the Ill
Consequence thereof may be In Respect
to this Governmt. wth great Respect
