Albany 20<sup>th</sup> September 1720

Appeared before Rutger Blecker Esq<sup>r</sup> Mayor  
of the City of Albany in presence of the Com<sup>r</sup> for Indian  
Affairs Jacob van Blarck Symon Veder William Hogan  
Jun<sup>r</sup> & Sybrant van Schaick all a ged who being duly  
Sworn on the holy Evangelists of almighty God declare  
that last winter while the Deponants were at ofwego  
Leut. John Price did not behave himself well there  
being sundry times in drink when he could not get  
strong liquor and often drank with the Soldiers then  
there by which means he was very troublesome to  
Cap<sup>t</sup> Nicolls the commanding officer the Deponants  
for the Depose that the s<sup>d</sup> Leut. Price in their Indgement  
is no fitt pers on to have the Comand of the Garrison  
at ofwego if he doth not behave himself better then  
he did at the time they were with him at ofwego  
and further their deponants say not
