May 1895 - Mr Woodall, Financial Secretary of War Office,
stated that "in the case of contracts for making of soldiers
clothing further conditions have recently been added
requiring that all wages paid shall be paid direct
to the workers, not through a firm; also that
the maps books of the firms employed, so far as the
contract is concerned shall be open to War Office in-
-spection." (Times May 18, 1895)
