

1882 the assignment was filed from
 Alfred Renaud one of the heirs at law
 of the late Fabien Renaud to Victoria
 LeBlanc who now stands in the books
 of the Department as owner of Alfred
 Renaud's share of his father's

Lot 40 Concession 8, 94 acres
 was sold to Herbert Renaud, September
 19th 1887, paid for in full, and now
 stands in the books in his name. The
 Department cannot therefore see how
 the heirs of Fabien Renaud should
 deal with this lot unless they can
 file a transfer from Herbert Renaud
 to Fabien Renaud prior to his
 death.
