Punnichy, July, 30th, 1917. 191

Sir,-

I beg to inform you that I have this day forwarded to you under separate cover a copy of the Annuity Pay Lists showing the payments made in this Agency in 1917.

I received the sum of \$5350.00 from the Bank of Montreal at Winnipeg and paid out \$5035.00 leaving a surplus of \$315.00 which I enclose herewith.

There were a large number of absentees from the Nut Lake reserve owing I was told to the bad condition of the roads.

The following is a summary of the pagments, -

5 Chiefs @ 25.00 125.00

8 Headmen 15.00 120.00

956 Indians 5.00 4780.00

2 Arrears 5.00 10.00
