Ottawa, 3rd January, 1918.

S1r:-

Referring to your letter of the 26th ultimo enclosing the consent of the St. Peter's Band to Mrs. Ellen Smith, commuting her annuity, I beg to state that a widow cannot commute her annuity. The only Indian women who may commute are those married to persons other than an Indian or a non-treaty Indian. See Sections 14 and 15 of the Indian Act.
