I have also to point out that the Department expects the ex-pupils who received loans to make prompt re-payment on the same. When it is not possible for them to comply with the Department's requirements in this respect, you should report the fact to Head-quarters. If any loans have been made which have not been repaid in full, you should deal with each separately and endeavour to make collection this Fall of the amounts due.
