NOTE.—Amherstburg Association is given as last year, as no report had come to hand for the current year. The remainder is taken from the *English Baptist Hand Book* for 1894. The figures from our own Convention are from the Associational minutes for 1894.

The summary is corrected to the year 1893. The sources from which it has been compiled are the returns from the English Churches, collected principally through the Associations; the statistics supplied by the Colonial and Foreign Unions and Associations, and information contained in the reports of various missionary societies. The figures given above include the approximate number of accredited members in recognized Baptist Churches, but do not include those who, holding the principle that baptism is a profession of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, are to be found in other denominations. On the other hand, deductions should be made of those who, not being Baptists, are to be found among Baptist Churches, having Open Fellowship. The Statistics of Sunday Schools and Baptisms are now given for the first time in this Summary, and no comparison is therefore possible with former years.—S. H. BOOTH, D.
