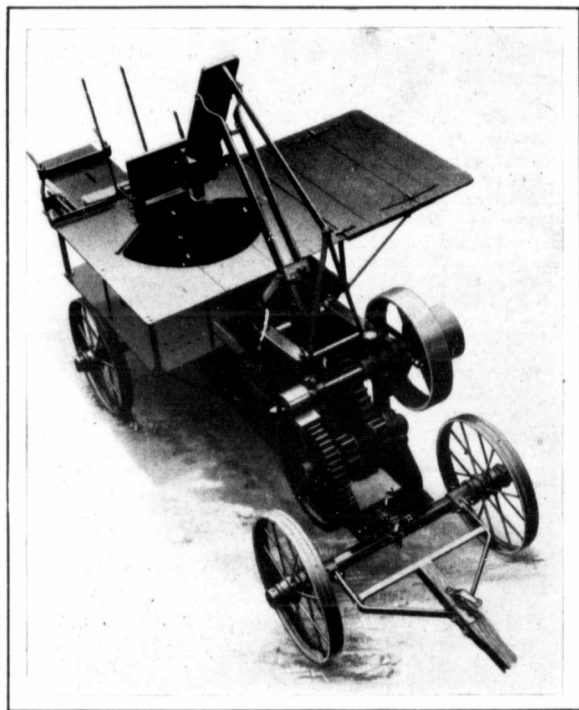


# CASE BALING PRESSES



Who's getting the baling business in your vicinity?

There must be a good deal. Farmers now almost generally demand that their hay be baled because, being easy to handle, it commands higher prices. The business is there for someone—why not for you?

When anyone thinks of a baling press, he immediately thinks of a CASE Baler, because—

**No. 1** Its large feed opening permits of easy, fast feeding.

**No. 2** Its condenser compresses the hay right under the feeder, so that the whole forkful goes into the baler at one time.

**No. 3** The CASE Baler is equipped with a friction clutch, which lets the flywheel get up to speed before the baler is started; there is slight possibility of throwing the belt.

**No. 4** It is built in two sizes, 14 x 18 inches and 17 x 22 inches. The former will bale from three and a half to five tons per hour; the latter from four to six.

If you have no use for a power baler, our horse power machine has been found by many farmers to meet their needs to a T. Its size is 14 x 18 inches, with a capacity of one and a half to two tons per hour.
