Lord Renfrew Now in Canada.

The arrival of the Prince of Wales in Canada (this time as Lord Renfrew) may be regarded as a purely business trip, that is, as an instance of the owner's personal interest in his agricultural affairs.

The Royal Prince, Edward, formerly the Beddingfield ranch of 1600 acres, is near High River, Alberta and about 40 miles south of Calgary. It has a comfortable home, up-to-date farm buildings, and is in full view of the snow capped Rocky mountains.

After purchasing the property, the Prince made arrangements for the shipment to Canada of thoroughbred horses from the Royal stud. Short-horns from the King's farm. Shropshire sheep from the Duke of Westminster's estate, and Dartmoor ponies from the Devonshire moors.

The manager of the ranch has recently returned from England with 23 head of shorthorn cattle, 40 head of pure breed Hampshire Down sheep, 3 young Clydesdale fillies, and the King's thoroughbred stallion "Will Somers," which as a three-year-old won several of the famous English races.

This establishment has already played an important part in the Western live stock industry, and its continuance will promote faith in the future, and will also be a stimulus to others engaged along the same lines.
