Gaiters Come in Shades of Fawn, Gray and White; Also in Black, Brown and Tan.

The hours of the clock are told by fashions in feminine foot wear. For morning there are English brogues in chocolate brown, light tan, Russian calf and black calfskin. The rounded brogue toe carries a wing tip and brass eyelets are "the thing" on these shoes.

If gaiters are desired they come in shades of fawn, gray and white for wear with low-heeled, wing-tipped pumps in black, brown and tan, reaching only to the spring of the instep.

The proper stockings for wear with brogues are ribbed wool, or silk and wool in plain shades or in Oxford and heather mixtures. The plain weave wool stockings are clocked in contrasting colors. Silk or French lisse stockings are worn with gaiters.

For afternoon wear there is a black vamp French heel shoe with a light gray or tan suede upper that is very attractive with dressy gowns. This model comes in patent leather and dull leather and also in brown kid.

If a Cuban heel is your choice, the straight tip tan leather shoe is smart for any daytime wear. This last is also made in black and chocolate brown.

Patent leather and brown French heel pumps without buckles are worn with spats by many smartly gowned women for afternoon wear.

The short vamp French slippers that tie on the instep are making great headway in America. They are made of suede for street wear and of black or colored satin for evening use. Worn with lace striped stockings they give the impression of smallness.

For evening wear there are high French heels and baby French heel slippers in silver, gold, brocade, velvet and satin. These slippers usually carry buckles. Rhinestone buckles are the most popular, although cut steel is also used.

Evening stockings are sheer and the fancy lace striped varieties are in great demand. Lace clocks are also popular and sheer black stockings with lace butterfly medallions inserted in front are also seen.

## NOTES OF FASHION

Round collars are used much in children's frocks.

The evening gown occasionally features a very light waist.

The popular length for skirt is eight inches from the floor.

Caramel-colored felt hats and also those in straw with footwear of the same color are apparently in high favor.

Rafia combined with very narrow strips of leather, braided together, form whole hat crowns. To replace the leather, shiny new straw is often used.

The fashion of trimming fur cloaks with pelts running otherwise is most successful and has been adopted by a number of houses this season.

Brocades continue to be the fabric de luxe for evening gowns. This wonderful metallic fabric has inspired a chiffon broche that consists of velvet flowers or figures woven on a background of chiffon cloth.

Ribbons are employed in countless ways. Wide ribbon belts are simply knotted at the sides so that the falling loops give a pannier effect, or at the back with long trailing ends, forming a substitute for the fishtail of last season.


