





GRAHAM CAKE .-- One cupful of brown sugar, one cupful of sour cream, two eggs (one will do), two cupsful of Graham flour, one teaspoonful of soda, a little salt and cinnamon if liked. If the cream is not very sour, use less soda. Do not stir too stiff.

MACARONI.—Make a good gravy with a small piece of beef cooked with some vegetables, herbs and a slice of ham; strain and add a little tomato sauce. Cook some macaroni in salted boiling water until tender; drain, put it in a baking dish with layers of Par-mesan cheese and the gravy. Sprinkle cheese and a little butter over the top; bake, and serve at once.

GINGER BREAD.—Three-quarters of a pound of butter, two and a half pounds of flour, one quart of black molasses, two teaspoonsiul of ginger, two teaspoonsiul of cinnamon, eight eggs, two teaspoonsful of sods.

SCRAMBLAD EGGS .- Break six eggs into a stew-pan, add three ounces of butter, a little salt and pepper; put the stew-pan over the fire and stir con-stantly; when done, which will be in three for minutes, serve imme-diately n todat.

EGGS A LA LAVELETTE. -- Pour into flat tin dish cream to the depth of a quarter of an inch, bring it to the boil quickly; then drop in sufficient eggs, and cook them till the whites are hard, season to taste, and serve in the same About one-quarter of a pint of cream to six eggs would be required.

BOSTON PUDDING—One cup of sugar, two-thirds of a cup of butter, or one-quarter of a poynd of suet, minced, on cup i milk, three cups of flour, two testpoordful of Geveland's Superior Daking Powder, two tablespoordful of moraneter of the cup o cup of seeded raising and a little salt. Boil four hours and serve with liquid sauce. 🕹

POACHED EGGS .- Fill a frying-pan with water, add a pinch of salt and a tablespoonful of vinegar; break the eggs separately in a cup, pour them carefully into the boiling water, with a small slice turn the white over the yelk; drain for a minute; serve on huttered toast. Two and a half minutes will be sufficient to cook them.

BEATEN BISCUIT .- Two pints of flour, one teaspoonful of salt, one tablespoonfulo latd; mix into a stiff dough, with equal parts of water and milk; beat thirty minutes with a wooden spoon; bake in a quick oven.

FRUIT CARE.—One cupful of brown sugar, one-half cupful of butter; beat together one cupful of sweet milk, one-half cupful of molasses, two eggs, three cupsful of flour, one teaspoonful each of elispice and ground cloves, one table-spoonful of cinnamon, half a nutmeg, one pound of raisins, one cupful of currants (rub them in flour before using), two tablespoonsful of cream of tartar, one of sods.


