

Training areas

If you are a graduate in one of the fields mentioned above, we shall relay your application to the German government who will undertake a job search on your behalf.

Working conditions

Trainees will not be admitted to Germany unless appropriate authorities are satisfied that the remuneration offered meets the prevailing rate for the occupation and locale. The authorities will also want to ensure that the terms of employment will be respected.

Trainees will enjoy the same treatment as nationals of the host country in all matters concerning the application of laws, regulations and practices regarding health and working conditions.

Travel arrangements

Trainees are responsible for their own travel arrangements. International and domestic transportation costs will normally be borne by the trainee.

The trainee is not entitled to enter Germany without being in possession of his or her entry authorization. It is highly recommended that an applicant obtain a work permit before departure for Germany.

On the expiration of the training period, trainees may not remain in the host country with a view to holding employment, except when expressly authorized to do so.
