*The Chargé d'Affaires, a.i. of the United States Embassy in Canada to the  
Secretary of State for External Affairs*

The Chargé d'Affaires ad interim of the United States of America presents his compliments to the Secretary of State for External Affairs and has the honor to refer to Note No. 167 of October 17, 1961 from the Secretary of State for External Affairs approving on behalf of the Canadian Government, subject to certain conditions, proposed channel improvements to be undertaken in Canadian waters along the sailing courses in Lake Erie, east of the Detroit River navigation light and through the Pelee Passage.

The Chargé d'Affaires ad interim of the United States of America has the honor to confirm the acceptance by the Government of the United States of America of the conditions set forth by the Canadian Government in its Note No. 167. That note and this reply thereto, together with the Ambassador's note No. 297 of June 8, 1959, shall constitute a special agreement between the two Governments under Article III of the Boundary Waters Treaty of January 11, 1909.
