AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

AND

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO CONCERNING

ECONOMIC AND TECHNICAL COOPERATION

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco, hereinafter called the "Contracting Parties";

ON THE BASIS of the cordial relations existing between the two countries and their peoples;

WISHING to strengthen and expand these relations;

CONSIDERING it to be their common interest to encourage the economic and technical development of their respective countries;

WISHING to lend a new dimension to their cooperation ties;

RESOLVED to encourage and promote direct relations between private corporations, professional associations, decentralized political bodies, and non-governmental organizations to create an environment conducive to political, economic and financial partnership;

RECOGNIZING the advantage of closer cooperation for both countries;

RECOGNIZING the need to amend the General Agreement concerning Economic and Technical Cooperation signed on October 13, 1981 (herein after called the "Agreement"), to better reflect the new dimension in cooperation between the two countries,
