

**AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO
CONCERNING
ECONOMIC AND TECHNICAL COOPERATION**

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco, hereinafter called the "Contracting Parties";

ON THE BASIS of the cordial relations existing between the two countries and their peoples;

WISHING to strengthen and expand these relations;

CONSIDERING it to be their common interest to encourage the economic and technical development of their respective countries;

WISHING to lend a new dimension to their cooperation ties;

RESOLVED to encourage and promote direct relations between private corporations, professional associations, decentralized political bodies, and non-governmental organizations to create an environment conducive to political, economic and financial partnership;

RECOGNIZING the advantage of closer cooperation for both countries;

RECOGNIZING the need to amend the General Agreement concerning Economic and Technical Cooperation signed on October 13, 1981⁽¹⁾ (herein after called the "Agreement"), to better reflect the new dimension in cooperation between the two countries.
