

University-to-university agreement for the exchange of students and faculty members. Last year, two students from Oldenburg studied at Saskatoon, but due to language problems no Canadian students participated in the exchange. There should be parity in the number of exchange students within a period of five years.

Applicants are expected to have more than second year standing, i.e. five semesters. In addition, German students should have at least 575 points at the TOEFL Test and demonstrate their interest and knowledge in an interview. The students are screened and selected by the program administrator in Germany and the respective counterpart in Saskatoon.

The program includes a tuition waiver on a one-to-one basis. Credits acquired at the host institution may be accepted by the home university.

The exchange is for one year, and German students can receive leave status if they wish.
