PRAYERS.

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the following Bill, without amendment:

Bill No. C-26, An Act to incorporate the Lakehead Harbour Commissioners.

On motion of Mr. Cardiff, seconded by Mr. Bell (Carleton), it was ordered,—That the name of Mr. Howard be substituted for that of Mr. Winch on the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce.

On motion of Mr. Cardiff, seconded by Mr. Bell (Carleton), it was ordered,—That the name of Mr. Fairfield be substituted for that of Mr. Horner (Jasper-Edson) on the Standing Committee on Miscellaneous Private Bills.

Mr. Nowlan, seconded by Mr. Brooks, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. C-51, An Act to amend the Customs Act, which was read a first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Nowlan, seconded by Mr. Brooks, moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole at its next sitting to consider the following proposed resolution which has been recommended to the House by His Excellency:

That it is expedient to establish a Board of Broadcast Governors to regulate broadcasting in Canada; to provide that the expenditure of the Board shall be paid out of money appropriated by Parliament therefor and also to
