

Courses at the University or affiliated Training Department at the University for not more than 10 hours per week.

Further enquiry is being made into the exact nature of Mr. Gower's work, but the report, as far as it goes, seems to indicate that his position is not unlike that of Mr. MacOdrum.

The foregoing may help to demonstrate the difficulties which have been attendant on the inauguration of the reciprocal scheme; but having regard to the genuine desire of all parties concerned to co-operate willingly and whole-heartedly, there seems every reason for assuming that if the scheme is continued and extended, these difficulties should be capable of being entirely overcome.
