
Appendix B.

URINALS.

The Dry Earth principle is equally applicable to Urinals, especially for schools and railway stations, and other public places. Selfacting machinery for these urinals is supplied by the Company, and all offensive smell may be prevented, and a valuable manure manufactured. There are public urinals frequented by 2,000 persons a day, and no one requires to be told of their offensiveness. Yet these places may, by the use of dry earth, be made perfectly inoffensive; and the value of the manure that is now wasted, but which then would be saved, would be highly remunerative.
