WRIT OF FIERI FACIAS ON A JUDGMENT OR ORDER
FOR COSTS.*(Court and Style of Cause.)*

EDWARD VII., &c., &c.

To the Sheriff of _____, Greeting:

We command you that of the goods and chattels and lands and tenements of _____ in your bailiwick you cause to be made the sum of \$ _____, for certain costs which by a judgment (or an order) or our High Court of Justice, dated the _____ day of _____, 18____, were adjudged (or ordered to be paid by the said _____ to _____, and which have been taxed and allowed at the said sum, and interest on the said sum at the rate of six per centum per annum, from the _____ day of _____, 18____, (the date of the certificate of taxation), and that you have before the Justices of our High Court, at Toronto, so much of the said sum and interest as you shall have made from the said goods and chattels immediately after the execution hereof, and so much thereof as you shall have made from the said lands and tenements immediately after the expiration of twelve months from the day of your receipt hereof, to be rendered to the said _____. And in what manner you shall have executed this our writ, make appear to us immediately after the execution hereof. And have there then this writ.
