Volume 1/Tamen in pretio est/York, U.C./Printed by John Carey, King Street." (Carey had in fact printed all but the first number). A dedication is added to Sir Peregrine Maitland, Lieutenant-Governor, and a preface of seven pages which gives some account of the constitution of the Province and the Court, with its former and present Judges, as well as of the inferior Courts. Of course, both dedication and preface disappear in the second edition.

Taylor also added a "Table of Cases reported," and at the end a complete Digest or "Index to the Principal Matters" of 5 and 32 pages respectively. His diligence did not extend to a "Table of Cases Cited."
