and Deacons. urch must be appointed by Upon recommendation by said committee, the candidates may, by vote of the church, be propounded for admission publicly, one fortnight before any regular communion service; and on said communion day, having assented to the articles of faith and covenant, may, by vote of the church, be admitted into full communion.

Persons may be received from other christian churches bringing letters of dismission and recommendation; the church reserving to itself the right of examining such applicants as regards their faith

and life.

Members of this church can become non-members alone by transfer to other christian churches; or by excommunication; or by

removal by death.

Members of this church moving from the city are required, within one year, to remove their relation to another christian church, if expedient, and if not, the church is to be informed of the difficulty in the way of said action.

This church considers immoral conduct, breach of express covenant vows, neglect of religious or relative duties, and avowed disbelief of its articles of faith, as offences deserving the censure of the

church.

This church deems the use of alcoholic liquors as a beverage a practice opposed to the spirit and will of Christ and accordingly to be considered an offence deserving the censure of the church.

The censures inflicted on offenders are private reproof, public admonition, suspension from church privileges or excommunication,

according to the nature of the offence.

No change shall be made in these principles and rules, unless at a regular meeting of the church, by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, provided always that when any alteration is contemplated, notice shall be given at a stated or regular meeting at least two weeks previous.
