When all this preliminary work is done the Secretary of the Royal Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals suggests that he should be communicated with, and a Form of affiliation be applied for, filled in and returned to him; and then the formation of your special branch of the "Band o Mercy" will be complete, and it will enjoy all the privileges which the Royal Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals offers to these junior branches in the sincere hope of gaining the interest and sympathy of the children.

Just a word of warning in your choice of the grown-up friend you ask to start your society, little friends; it must be someone who has a real love for children and animals because it would never do to get a "Band' started, and for it to be a failure.
