QTTAWA, Dec. 12.—(Special.)—

Mr. Perley was born in New Hampshire and is therefore a naturalized British subject in Canada. In Canada naturalization of an American citizen is not recommended. ada naturalization of an American citizen is not recognized outside of Canada by the imperial government. The American settler naturalized in Canada is not a British subject outside of Canada. It is hoped that some action may soon be taken which will make a British subject anywhere a British subject everywhere, but until this is done Canadian naturalization will confer no rights in the United Kingdom.
