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- Q.249 Did you sign, as has been suggested by the Prosecution, did you sign a Work Ticket for Tengum to take this jeep with the tires?
A.249 No.
- Q.250 Did - that week, did you sign any Work Tickets for vehicles going any place except - other than on the Monday?
A.250 Other than on the Monday morning I never saw any Work Tickets in the squadron lines, that week.
- Q.251 There has also been a question brought out that you phoned from the squadron orderly room to the border to make some arrangements about a jeep going across. Did you phone anyone from any office to make arrangements for a jeep to go across the border?
A.251 No sir.
- Q.252 You said earlier in your evidence that you took the doctor's advice and stayed in beddall week.
A.252 Yes sir.
- Q.253 Is there a phone in your room?
A.253 No sir.

The witness is cross-examined by the Prosecutor:

- Q.254 Captain Jessop, I would just like to get straight in my mind, exactly what transpired when De Bartok first approached you for permission to go - to have transport to go to Gronigen in order to bring wedding presents. He saw his troop commander?
A.254 I have no idea what transpired between him and his troop commander.
- Q.255 But his troop commander approached you, I believe?
A.255 Yes.
- Q.256 What did he ask for?
A.256 He had told me that De Bartok wanted to take some presents down to his fiancee whom he was planning to marry in the near future.
- Q.257 And you gave your OK to that, did you?
A.257 Yes.
- Q.258 And how was he supposed to go down?
A.258 How was he supposed to go down?
- Q.259 Yes.
A.259 I had proposed to give, or make available a vehicle for Corporal De Bartok.
- Q.260 And you proposed to have Lance-Corporal Tengum drive De Bartok down?
A.260 No, not at the time I was discussing the matter.
- Q.261 No, but a little later you decided that you would have Tengum drive him.
A.261 On Monday morning, yes.
- Q.262 The Monday before the Wednesday?
A.262 Yes.
- Q.263 Despite the fact that on De Bartok's own admission this morning that he is a fully qualified driver you had some other driver to drive him. Can you give me a rational explanation of that?
A.263 Yes. Within the squadron and in the regiment our vehicles are assigned to one driver. Other people were not supposed to drive that vehicle.
- Q.264 And that is the reason why you got Corporal Tengum, or more or less detailed Tengum to take De Bartok?
A.264 That's right.
