

Preamble, intended to be proposed

WHEREAS the making, maintaining and keeping in repair a Turnpike Road from the bottom of Côte d'Abraham, commencing at the point at which the two roads at present leading to Dorchester Bridge and to Scott's Bridge now separate from each other, to the Church of Ancient Lorette, in the County of Quebec, will be of great advantage to the Inhabitants of the adjacent Country; and by opening a nearer and more convenient communication between the said place and the Town of Quebec, will be of great public utility: May it therefore please your Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal
