First returned for Parlt. for Cardwell, 14 Dec. 1876. Returned for North Simcoe g.e., 1878, and re-elected g.e.. 1882, 1887 and 1891. A Conservative. - Toronto: Rideau Club.

McDonald, John Archibald. (Victoria, N.S.)

Parents came from Kilmuir, Isle of Skye, Scot. Second s. of Lauchlan McDonald, North East Margaree, N.S. B there, 25 Feb., 1851. E.J. at Horton Academy and Acadia Col., Wolfville, N.S. M., 27 Jan.. 1885, Katie Jeannette, only dau. of the late Thos. Hume. Halifax. Cailed to the Bar, N.S., 8 Dec., 1877. Was one of the Ex. Committee of the Cape Breton Exhibitions in 1880 and 1884. Is a Trustee of the Baddeck Academy and has been Clerk to the Municipality of Victoria. Sat in the Nova Scotia Assem. from g.e. 1882. until g.e., 1886, when he was not a candidate. First returned to Commons at g.e., 1887. The election being declared void, he was re-elected, 21 Nov., 1887. Reelected at last g.e. A Conservative.—Baddeck, Caps Breton N.S.
