HIS Royal Highness the Commander in Chief, in consequence of his late Inspection, having thought it necessary, for the future Guidance of the Generals, Officers, and Soldiers, to give out the following Orders—Is pleased to direct that the same be communicated to all the Corps of Cavalry and Insantry in the Service; and that they shall be entered, observed, and considered as Standing Orders, in further Explanation of His Majesty's Regulations for the Field Exercise and Movements of the Troops.
