Major issues face new council

● (continued from page 1) status and the annexation of the whole of Streetsville.

HEARING

A hearing has yet to be held to decide the matter at provincial level as well as to decide the future of Streetsville's application to annex nearly 10,000

acres of Mississauga and Oakville.

Another current sore point is the proposed construction of an industrial waste treatment plant in Clarkson - a project which council has little say over but one which has roused the ire of many area residents.

A public meeting to discuss the issue has been arranged in January by the provincial government, to release information on the project and to answer questions about it.

The year will also see considerably more development of the Mississauga City Centre, including the completion of the town's new civic centre and a mammoth regional shopping centre.

Work on Erin Mills New Town and the combined Markborough development will also get well under way.

For council it will be a busy year but Mayor Robert Speck is confident that the new council is a good, solid one.

Mr. Gregory, known by his friends as Bud, will be serving his first term in public office, but he is already known as a man who becomes involved in public causes.

Mr. Gregory, 44, of Silverplains Dr., is a director of Fleetwood Village Homeowners' Association, serving as its president in 1968.

FOUGHT NOISE

He played a leading role in the organization of the Mississauga "wing" of the Society for Aircraft Noise Abatement which successfully fought the federal government plan for the major development of Malton Airport.

He is manager and chief coach of the 1970 Ontario Champion Juvenile Girls' Softball team and branch manager of a life insurance

company in the Dixie area.

Mr. Grice, owner and operator of Hawthorne Valley Golf and Country Club, has had considerable experience in the field of public affairs.

Chairman of the former Township of Toronto Board of Education, he was first chairman of the recently-formed Peel County Board of Education and has been a trustee of the county board up to the end of this year.

The 1971-74 town council is: Mayor - Robert Speck; Reeve - Chic Murray; Deputy-reeve - Grant Clarkson; Councillors: Ward 1 - Harold Kennedy; Ward 2 - Lou Parsons; Ward 3 - Milton Gregory; Ward 4 - Glenn Grice; Ward 5 - Frank McKechnie; Ward 6 - Jack Kehoe; and Ward 7 - Ron Searle.

At Monday's inaugural meeting council will also be appointing two members to sit with the mayor, reeve and deputy-reeve on Peel County council. Mr. Parsons is expected to be returned to his county seat to seek election as council chairman and one other councillor is to be appointed because of a 1970 population boom.

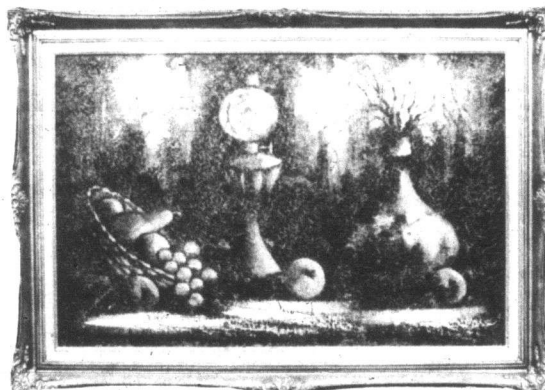
