

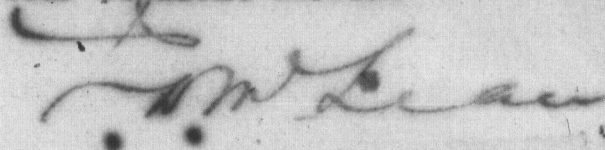

Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 19th Instant, reporting that complaints have been made as to the poor quality of the flour received as rent for the Shannonville Mill-site, I beg to say that the lease provides that there shall be paid yearly for the use of the Mohawk Indians the rent of 30 barrels of good merchantable flour and in order to avoid future complaints, it will be necessary for you hereafter to see the flour delivered and only accept same, provided it is of good merchantable quality.
