
Ottawa, 23rd November, 1910-

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th Instant, enquiring as to whether this Department had issued a Permit to the Spanish River Lumber Company to cut Timber on Aird Island, and in reply to inform you that the burned timber on this Island was sold by public tender to Mr. J. O. Smith, of Sudbury, on 1st March last, the consent of your Department having been first obtained, as set forth in your letter of the 21st January, 1910, No. 2021/99, addressed to the Secretary of this Department.
