With respect to the claim of your client, John McPherson, against this Department for wages carned while working at the Peigan saw-mill, I beg to say that the Department has made inquiry regarding it, and, on the information supplied, it does not appear that the Department is liable. The Department, therefore, cannot recognize this claim.
