



Ottawa, Ont., February 20, 1912.

Gentlemen,=

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th instant in regard to arrears due under licenses 40, 42 and 64 and in reply to say that there is a balance of \$665.80 due to the Department on license No. 64, Cockburn Island, for short payment of Crown Dues, Ground Rent and Renewal fees to 30th of April 1912 and on license No. 40, Township of Dawson a balance for similar items of \$412.51, also on License No. 42, Township of Robinson a balance of \$121.31 making as stated a total indebtedness of \$1199.62. I may say that these licenses have not been renewed since 1908 and during the intervening period there was some indebtedness on each license making up the total sum above stated which will require to be repaid before the licenses can be renewed.
