



In further reference to your letter of the 11th ultimo with which you submitted a request from some of the Indians of the Moosomin Reserve for the establishment of an undenominational school at Murray Lake I beg to say that the Department is not prepared to comply with their request at present. I may add that the services of Mr. Rotsey, the present teacher, are being dispensed with and the Department trusts that conditions will improve under a new teacher.
