I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, in regard to the lease of land you are desirous to give to Mr. John Shuster, the N^o. of Lot being numbered 100, Range 2, Gareton, and in reply to said letter would say that it is suggested that there has been a mistake in your entry in this matter, but the local agent who has been here this day has advised that permission should be granted for one year, and if the lessee is willing to take the land for this time, on the Department will meet your wishes, but, if he wishes it for the full term, five years, it will be necessary to comply with terms agreed to in agreement without
